2.GENDER BASED INCLUSION ENSURED BY THE DIFFERENT MEASURES UNDERTAKEN BY THE INSTITUTE FOR GENDER EQUITY

A. Safety and Security-

- a. Well-trained and vigilant women police personnel has been deployed outside the college gates.
- b. PCR Van have been deployed in mobile positions outside the college during opening and closing hours.
- c. The college has a Women Cell and an Anti-Sexual Harassment Cell to help, guide and assist girl students in case of incidents of harassment on and off campus.
- d. Women empowerment practises/ Taekwondo/ self-defence workshops are organised from time to time to equip girls in self-defence.
- e. Night patrols by college security guards are regularly undertaken. Chowkidars are present round the clock on campus entrance and in the hostel.
- f. The college campus has an extensive surveillance network with a 24*7 monitored control room. CCTV's have been installed all over the campus for keeping a strict vigil over all the activities going on in the college in order to ensure safety and security of the students and the staff. At present, 78 cameras have been installed in the campus.
- g. Strict implementation of Anti-Ragging and Anti-Smoking rules is followed in the college.
- h. Awareness campaigns on women safety and gender sensitization through street plays, rallies. etc. are held from time to time in order to sensitise students.

B. Counselling-

- a. Formal and informal avenues have been set up for counselling female students regarding academic and personal issues by the Women Cell.
- b. Proctorial Committees and teacher incharges are available for counselling of female students.
- c. Placement Cell and Alumni Assistance Cell for Career Counselling has been set up.
- d. Medical Counselling, Moral Counselling through medical camps and workshops on good nutrition. Campaigns against female foeticide and women rights, etc. are regularly held on campus.

C. Common Room-

- a. The room next to the canteen has been designated as a common room for the students. It is equipped with different games like carrom, Ludo, etc. It is a place for girl students to relax, have their tiffin and engage in meaningful communication
- b. In the Departments common staff rooms have been allocated for staff members in order to facilitate meetings and discussions.
- c. Day Care Centre for kids of college faculty and students: Women are playing important roles these days both as homemakers and at their workplaces. In order to fulfil a long-standing demand. A Day Care Centre" was established under the aegis of RUSA in our college on 23 September. 2017. It was a welcome step with initial enrollment of 5 children. Gradually the number rose to 30 children of not only teaching and non-teaching staff but also of married girl students studying in different courses in the college. Rates

per month for full day (8:30 a.m to 4:30 p.m) per child was fixed at Rs.2000/- whereas the rate for siblings was fixed at 50% for full day. Rate per month for half day (12:30 a.m to 4:30 p.m) for one child was fixed at Rs.1000/- and for siblings was 50% for half a day.

- d. Other initiatives undertaken - The college ensures active participation of students in co curricular activities including sports as it is one of the core courses of the Programmes.

- j. Taking over the charge of the helpline along with other faculty members. Involvement in purchase of books and psychological tests required for counselling.
- k. Sending relevant articles and messages through e- mails to the entire college staff.
- l. Contact the parents and teachers in need and discuss the problems as well the action to be taken.
- m. Informing the principal about chronic cases and keeping her informed time to time about the counselling given which showcases sensitivity of the Institution towards Inclusiveness.

5. RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING ADMISSION TO VARIOUS COURSES (SESSION 2021-2022)

- Notwithstanding anything contained in this document to the contrary, the “Instructions for Admission to Various Courses” of Panjab University, Chandigarh, or any subsequent instructions to be issued by Panjab University, Chandigarh, for the session 2021-2022 shall apply.
- Any instructions or rules received from the Director Higher Education, Chandigarh Administration/Panjab University, Chandigarh, after the publication of this prospectus, will be binding on the candidates.

General Information

1. The candidates are to be admitted strictly in accordance with the Rules and Regulations contained in the latest calendars/guidelines/any other Instructions which have been issued/may be issued from time to time by the Panjab University, Chandigarh, for the respective courses/examinations and in order of merit.
2. All the admissions to these institutions are provisional and subject to the approval of the Panjab University, Chandigarh. The institution cannot be held responsible in case the University does not approve the admission of a student on account of giving incomplete information, concealing necessary facts or attaching incomplete testimonials or choosing wrong combination of subjects or delayed submission of certificates etc. The fine/penalty imposed by Panjab University, Chandigarh, for any default in this regard shall be the personal responsibility of the candidate.
3. Candidates disqualified by any University/Board shall not be admitted.
4. Concealment of facts/furnishing of false information in the Admission Form will lead directly to the cancellation of admission and the amount deposited as fee will be forfeited.
5. For admission, fraction of marks less than the requisite percentage would not be rounded off to the advantage of the candidates, i.e. 32.9%, 39.9% and 49.9% shall not be rounded off to 33%, 40% and 50% etc.
6. **Late Admission with Vice-Chancellor's Permission**
 - a. Permission of the Vice-Chancellor, Panjab University is necessary for admission after the expiry of the last date for admission given with the Principal's permission.
 - b. A candidate, whose result of 10+2 examinations has not been declared by the School Board, may be admitted without late fee within 15 working days of the declaration of the result, depending upon the availability of seats and the fact that the Admission Form has been submitted as 'Result Awaited Case' before the last date of submission of Admission Forms. The attendance of such a student shall be counted from the date of admission. This would be applicable to Open School also. After expiry of this period, late admission approval from the Vice-Chancellor is required. See Rule 10 at Page No. 355 of Panjab University Calendar Vol-III, 2016.
 - c. In case of late declaration of result by Panjab University, normal admission will take place within 10 working days of declaration of the result. This rule will not apply to a candidate who passes the lower examination from any other University/Board.

7. Hostel Admission

- a. Hostel admissions will be considered only for those candidates who have opted for hostel while applying in Online Admission Form.
- b. Hostel admissions are non-centralized and are done by the respective college on the merit basis to which the candidate is admitted.
- c. It is mandatory for the Parent/Guardian of the candidate to be present at the time of admission.
- d. **Wards of Defence/ Para-Military Personnel (Outside UT Pool) who are admitted in the colleges are eligible to take admission in the respective college hostel.**
- e. Due to Covid-19 pandemic situation, hostel seat allotment will be restricted and will be on availability. Therefore, the colleges will workout the modalities regarding hostel seat allotment as and when physical classes will take place, keeping in view the SOP's guidelines issued by GOI and Chandigarh Administration from time to time. Hence, the candidates are advised to visit respective college website regularly.

8. Re-admission

- a. **A student who remains absent for more than 10 days at a stretch, including holidays, in one or more than one subjects/periods, without sanctioned leave, is liable to have his/her name struck off from the college rolls.**
- b. If a student's name is struck off from the college rolls, he/she will be required to seek re-admission within 10 working days, failing which his/her admission will stand cancelled.
- c. Re-admission fee of Rs. 150/- will be charged. It is mandatory for the student to bring his / her parent at the time of re-admission.
- d. Re-admission is not the right of every student. It is the prerogative of the Principal of the respective college and it is allowed for not more than two times per semester/per session.
- e. The attendance of the student seeking re-admission will however be counted from the first day of teaching and not from the date of re-admission.

9. Migration

Students from other colleges affiliated to Panjab University, Chandigarh, may be allowed to migrate with the prior permission of the concerned Principals and as per the University rules and regulations. He/she has to submit **College Leaving Certificate** from the previous college along with the other certificates.

- a. No migration will be permitted to a student with a combination of subjects which is not provided in the concerned colleges.
- b. Students who are not from Panjab University, Chandigarh, are required to submit the Migration Certificate.
- c. Mid-term migration from any other University is not allowed.

Note: A student of any other University who is placed in compartment in 1st and 2nd Semester/3rd and 4th Semester of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A./B.B.A. Course be not allowed to join the 5th and 6th Semester Course of this University.

10. Deficient Subjects

A candidate who has passed his / her 1st and 2nd Semester of B.A./B.Sc.(General)/B.Com./B.B.A./B.C.A. course conducted by another University/College affiliated to another University in India under specific authorization by the University concerned, be allowed to migrate to a College affiliated to Panjab University/Department of Evening Studies/ University School of Open Learning in the 3rd Semester/5th Semester of the respective Course (as per rules prescribed under Chapter XIV –'Migration of Students' Page No.292 to 309 of P.U. Calendar Volume-III, 2019) on the condition that such a candidate will have to clear the Deficient Subject/s if any, within the permissible chances.

Deficiencies should be determined by the Principal/Chairperson at the time of admission under intimation to the University (i.e. on the Registration Return and examination forms) as well as to the students as per University Rule No.6 given at Page No.310-311 of P.U. Calendar Volume – III, 2019.

- a. A candidate seeking admission to any college after migration from Universities **other than** the Panjab University shall clear deficient subjects, if any, as determined by the College/University.
- b. Deficient subject is one which is not passed by the candidate in the previous institution in that class and is required to be qualified for admission to next higher class.
- c. The candidate should be asked to furnish the details of the courses he/she has covered in his/her previous institution, i.e. course contents etc. and that should be certified by the Principal/competent authority of the previous institution.
- d. In case of students who have passed their B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.B.A./B.C.A.Part I/II examination from Universities other than those from the Punjab State there should be no deficient subjects. In case the student had covered more than 50% of the syllabus prescribed by the Panjab University in a subject it shall not be treated to be a deficient subject.

11. Foreign Students

All foreign students shall obtain Eligibility Certificate from Deputy Registrar (General) Panjab University, Chandigarh, in all cases and the admission of the foreign students to College/Teaching Departments would be governed by the Guidelines issued by the Dean, Foreign Students. The eligibility form should be accompanied by a forwarding letter from the Principal of the College/ Chairperson of the Teaching Department indicating the reason for denying the admission to the candidate. After obtaining the Eligibility Certificate, the candidate should submit the same to College/Department where he/she is seeking admission.

 - d. Date of Birth Certificate with the Father's/ Mother's name
 - e. Eligibility Certificate from the Panjab University, Chandigarh, to desired course
 - f. Original Letter of Certificate from present institution
 - g. Original Migration Certificate
 - h. Academic certificates and testimonials
 - i. Original letters of scholarships in case of those who are Government of India sponsored scholars
- 12. Withdrawal of Admission and Refund of Fee** The information regarding the same will be uploaded on DHE website www.dhe.chd.gov.in as and when the norms/guidelines will be issued by University Grants Commission / Panjab University, Chandigarh/ Chandigarh Administration.
- a. Student admitted in **Government College** can apply for Fee Refund or De-allocation of Seat through his/her respective login at DHE website www.dhe.chd.gov.in
 - b. Student admitted in **Privately Managed Aided College** has to refer to the respective college prospectus/ website regarding fee refund.

6. NIJAAT: THE DRUG DE ADDICTION SOCIETY AND ANTI SEXUAL HARASSMENT CELL:

Nijaat- the Stress Management and Drug De-addiction Society and NSS Wing of Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector42, Chandigarh in collaboration with the Department of Social Welfare, Women and Child Development, Chandigarh Administration organized various activities under NashaMukt Bharat to generate awareness about the harmful effects of drug/substance abuse. The theme of the campaign was, 'Just say no to Drugs/Standing against Drug Abuse'. The campaign consisted of a variety of activities to sensitize the youth.

Two-month long activities commenced with a National Webinar on February 4, 2021 titled —The Role of Youth in NashaMukt Bharat Campaign delivered by Mr. Manish Kumar, Team Leader SPYM Chandigarh. As many as 500 participants attended the webinar. Mr. Manish Kumar explained how the drug abuse is spreading all over the world and it is trapping especially the youth and children, as they are considered as the future of a nation so by involving them in drug abuse means destroying the future of that country. He has also suggested the various roles that youth can play to wage the war against drugs.

The organizing committee conducted a plethora of creative competitions at inter college level with an aim of involving the students to read and analyse the ill-effects of drugs. Poster Making, Rangoli, Creative Writing and Rewriting of Song, Poem Writing, and Creative Video Competitions were held in the month of January and February 2021. Poster Making Competition and Rangoli Competition saw colourful expressions of youth to describe the detrimental consequences of drugs. Entries under poem writing, creative song writing and rewriting and video competitions showcased the expressive thoughts of students related to drug abuse. More than 180 students participated in the events.

The events have been held with the intention of curbing the drug menace. The committee plans to keep on conducting different types of activities and be an added workforce towards NashaMukt Bharat.

Women Cell and Anti Sexual harrassment committee

As per the guidelines of ministry of women and Child Welfare, GOI, women cell and Anti Sexual harassment committee is working in tandem with the college authorities to ensure women safety in and around the college campus. Regular lectures, workshops and awareness drives are conducted to sensitize the students and the staff regarding women empowerment and their rights.
