



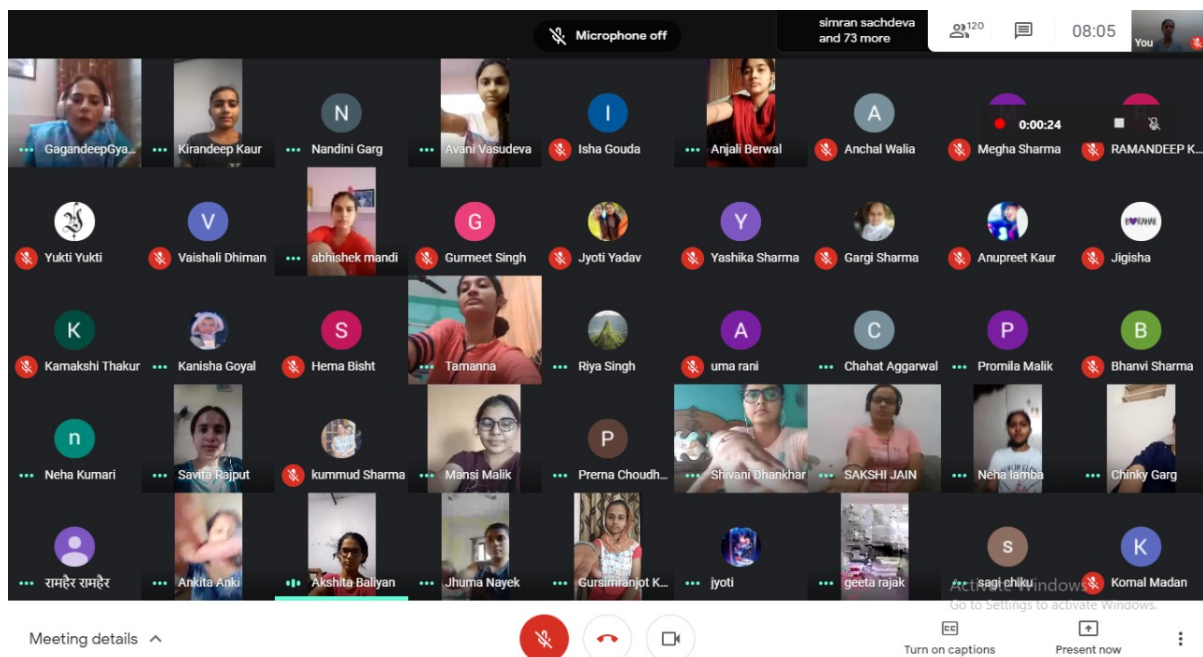

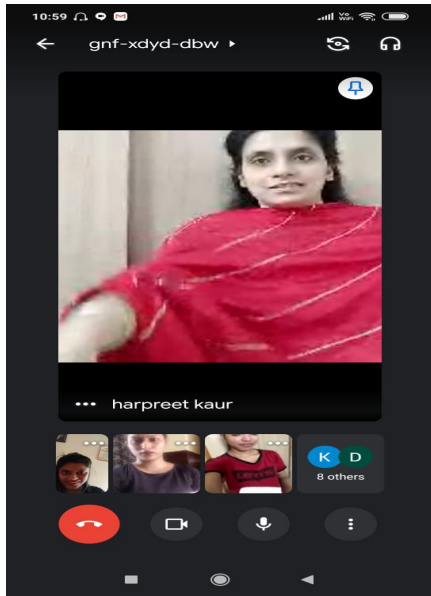
VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK 2020 (October 27th to November 2nd 2020)

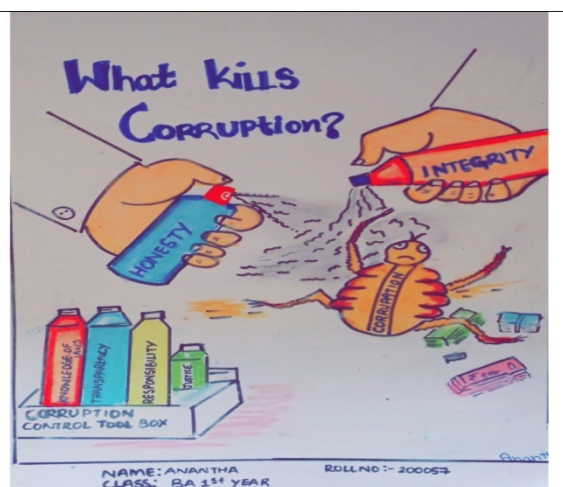
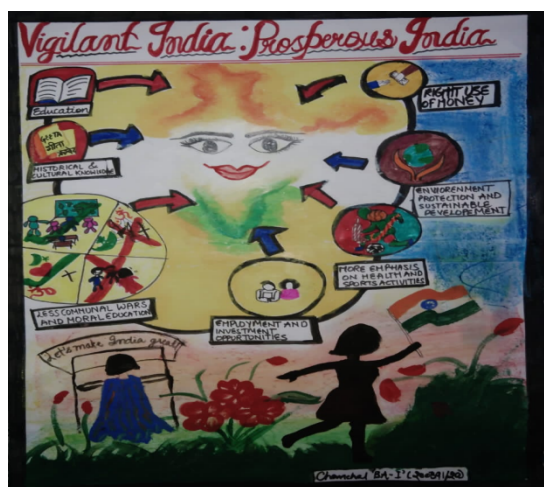
well as in poster making competitions. NSS Programme Officers Dr. Gagandeep Gyani and Ms. Kalyani were the event incharges.
