# 26<sup>th</sup> November 2020


The Constitution of India is the supreme law of India. The document lays down the framework demarcating fundamental political code, structure, procedures, powers, and duties of government institutions and sets out fundamental rights, directive principles, and the duties of citizens. It is the longest written constitution of any country on earth. B. R. Ambedkar, chairman of the drafting committee, is widely considered to be its chief architect. It was adopted by the Constituent Assembly of India on 26 November 1949 and became effective on 26 January 1950.

The NSS wing of Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42 Chandigarh celebrated "CONSTITUTION DAY 2020" on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2020. On this occasion of 71<sup>st</sup> Sambhidan Divas (Constitution Day) different activities were organized in the college i.e. Pledge administering programme about the Preamble of the Constitution of India, lecture on the life and work of Dr. B.R. 

Dean, Mrs Kamlesh Puri Reading the Preamble to Teaching and Non Teaching Staff Members




Pictures showing Pledge taking ceremony/ reading of Preambles


