#### Summer Internship Programme

During this program Tree Plantation on World environment day done with Indo Tibetan border Police, cleanliness drive at school community centre and streets of villages, awareness regarding waste segregation and management, personal hygiene, health awareness survey etc.activities had done by the volunteers.
