Rules & Regulations for TALENT HUNT competition scheduled for 14th & 15th September 2022.

I RANGOLI

1. 3 feet x 3feet space will be available for preparing Rangoli.
2. Only dry material for colours is allowed (Saw dust, sand-colour, etc).
3. Time allowed will be 2 hours 30 minutes.
4. Accessories are allowed.

II MEHNDI

1. A traditional Mehndi design has to be applied on the front and back of the hand and up to the elbows.
2. Time allowed is 2 hours.
3. Each participants can apply Mehndi on their own hands or can bring a model with them.

III PHULKARI, BAGH & CROSS STITCH/DASUTI

1. Khaddar Casement of 18 inches x 18 inches will be provided by the college.
2. For Phulkari a design of 4inches x 4 inches should be made.
3. For Bagh the design should not be less than 2inches x 2inches.
4. For Cross stitch/Dasuti design will be provided by the college.
4. For all embroideries a minimum of 3 colours should be used.
5. All participants should bring their own threads, needles, frames etc.
6. Time allowed is 3 hours.

IV KNITTING & CROCHET

1. A minimum design of 5inches x 5inches should be made.
2. Wool should be used for knitting & thread should be used for crochet.
3. All participants should bring their own materials.
4. Time allowed is 3 hours

V PAKHI DESIGNING

1. The frame for Pakhi will be provided by the college.
2. Only cotton threads are allowed.
3. Only traditional motifs should be made by the method of weaving
4. No patch work is allowed.
5. Time allowed is 3 hours.
