

Action taken Report 2019-20

Under the stewardship of principal Prof. (Dr) Nisha Aggarwal, the IQAC of the college took the following initiatives for the development of the college:

Initiative 1: infrastructural enhancements:

- A major project of the Girls' Hostel of 22 crores has also been approved.
- Electrical repairs in the Housing colony of group D Employee etc. amounting to approx. 3.5 crores was done.
- Plagiarism Detection Software Urkund, DELNET, RFID system were added in the library.
- Rewiring of electrical installations and replacement of tube fitting with LED fixtures done in IT Block under 4202.
- Purchase and installation of Generator Set for Auditorium block completed
- Old and defective ceiling fans replaced and AC points provided in Administrative block and Science block.
- Renovation of washrooms for students in science block done under 4202.
- The work of renovation of ground floor corridor of science block and porch area of the college completed.

Initiative 2: ICT enhancements:

- Redesigning and extension of services in College website www.gcg42.ac.in done.
- Upgradation of ICT facility by purchasing of 03 computers, 14 printers, 04 CCTVs and MS Office.
- G-Suite for education subscription was taken for smooth conducting of online classes and other teaching learning activities during the Covid19 pandemic.
- Faculty was provided training to take online classes using G-suite/Microsoft Teams.

- Capacity Building Programme on Curriculum Reforms and Latest QIF of NAAC conducted.
- Panjab University Zonal Youth and Heritage Festival, Chandigarh Zone B conducted in the college in September 2019

- Two new PG courses i.e. MA Punjabi and MA History started.
- a separate committee to collect data on Student Satisfaction using google form as per the criterion 2 - Student Satisfaction Survey. More than 50% students participated in the survey and suggested constructive improvement in the college academic and physical infrastructure.
