

Action Taken Report 2018-19

Under the stewardship of principal Prof. (Dr) Binu Dogra, the IQAC of the college facilitated the following initiatives in the college:

Initiative 1: infrastructural enhancements:

- Setting up of the Day Care Center, Research Lab in Life Sciences One Computer laboratory set up under UGC, RUSA and FIST.
- An existing Lecture Theatre converted into Mini Seminar Room.
- Hostel kitchen Upgraded into modernized modular kitchen.
- Renovation of hostel washrooms.
- Renovation of hostel mess.
- The civil work of installation of lift in the IT Block completed.
- Washrooms in the academic/ administrative block renovated.
- Provision of more washrooms have been made for persons with disability.
- Installation of additional water coolers with RO facility in Hostel and Academic Block.
- 7 new Water Coolers have been installed in the college.

Initiative 2: Academic Enhancements:

- All formalities for approvals for PG programmes namely MA History and MA Punjabi completed to enable starting the programs from the session 2019-20.
- Honours programmes in Physics, Zoology, Chemistry, Dance and Music (Instrument) started.

Initiative 3: For holistic development:

- Job Fest (February 2019) held for UG and PG students with participation of more than 20 companies.
- Multiple workshops and seminars held for the benefit of students, teaching and non- teaching faculty.
- Online submission of practical files, projects and assignments in CDs and email.
- Capacity Building Workshops/Seminars conducted to apprise stakeholders of the New Framework pertaining to AQAR submission and revised guidelines for assessment and accreditation.

Initiative 4: ICT enhancements:

- 22 computers,01 LCD/LED,01 Kiosk,01 Biometric machine,12 CCTV and 2 Projectors purchased.
- To collect data for NIRF and AQAR, a Google form was developed.
- Online submission of practical files, projects and assignments in CDs and email.

Initiative 5: Eco-Friendly Campus initiatives:

- A Fruit Garden with 25 different trees including a Sandalwood tree has been established at the back of the Hostel premises to be maintained by the Department of BCA.
