REPORT ON ACTIVITIES ORGANISED TO CELEBRATE INDIA'S
G20 PRESIDENCY

Assuming the G20 presidency in December, India has begun its one year journey with a unique outreach campaign in an effort to involve the youth of the country. With the expectation that India's G20 Presidency should touch every student across all the departments, PGGCG-42, Chandigarh has undertaken a range of events and activities on G20 themes spread across the year. **Under the direction of Principal Prof. (Dr.) Nisha Aggarwal and guidance of the Nodal Officer, Prof. Sudhir Hindwan and his team of faculty members Dr Gurjinder Singh, Ms. Shaktee Pathak, Dr. Rashmi Kohli, Mr. Sumit Dabhi and Dr. Shagun Sharma** organized various events in the institution. The students have and will be given an opportunity to bring in new ideas and perspectives to G20-related topics throughout the year. This would help to educate and sensitize the students about G20 and its significance under India's presidency.

The activities included quiz competitions, essay writing competition, painting and debating competitions at various level (intra college as well as inter college). The Quiz competition held by the Department of Political Science had questions that were designed to increase awareness about G- 20 and its importance in promoting peace and harmony. The main objective of the quiz competition included creating awareness about the historical background of the Summit, developing knowledge of the countries and to encourage students to relate to different parameters of G-20. To enhance the concept and practice of urban governance, teaching, research etc. an online Essay

writing competition was also held on the topic ‘The Tradition of Local Self Government in India’ by the Department of Economics. The Fine Arts Department held a poster making competition, where the students participated enthusiastically. They designed colorful posters conveying digital service or e- government service which is getting prioritize by governments worldwide. Yoga: an idea by our Honorable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is now a global phenomenon. The Students undertook the yoga activity to spread a wider awareness. The echo of patriotic songs and to feel proud of one’s nation and its rich culture was undertaken by the Department of Music. 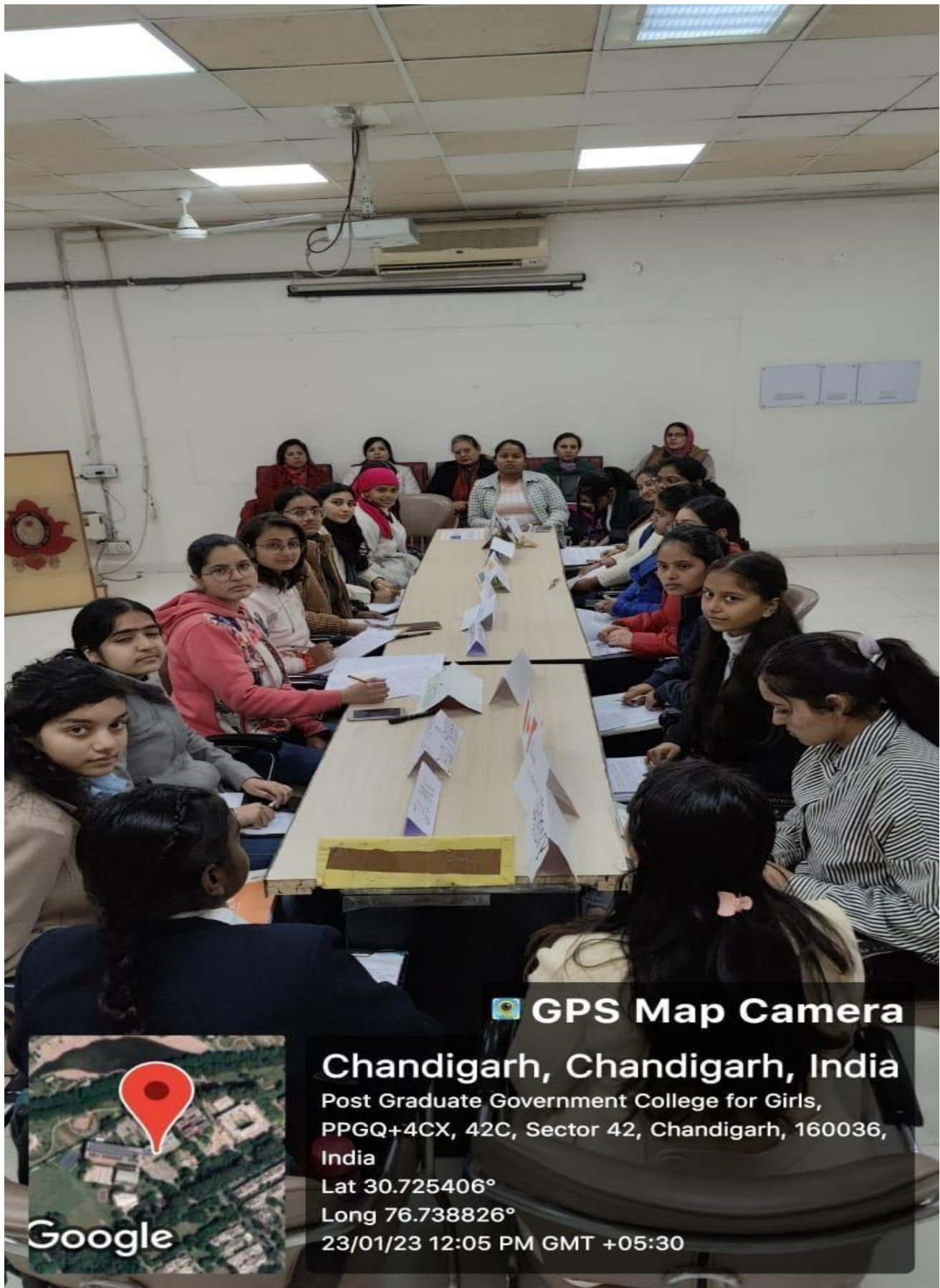

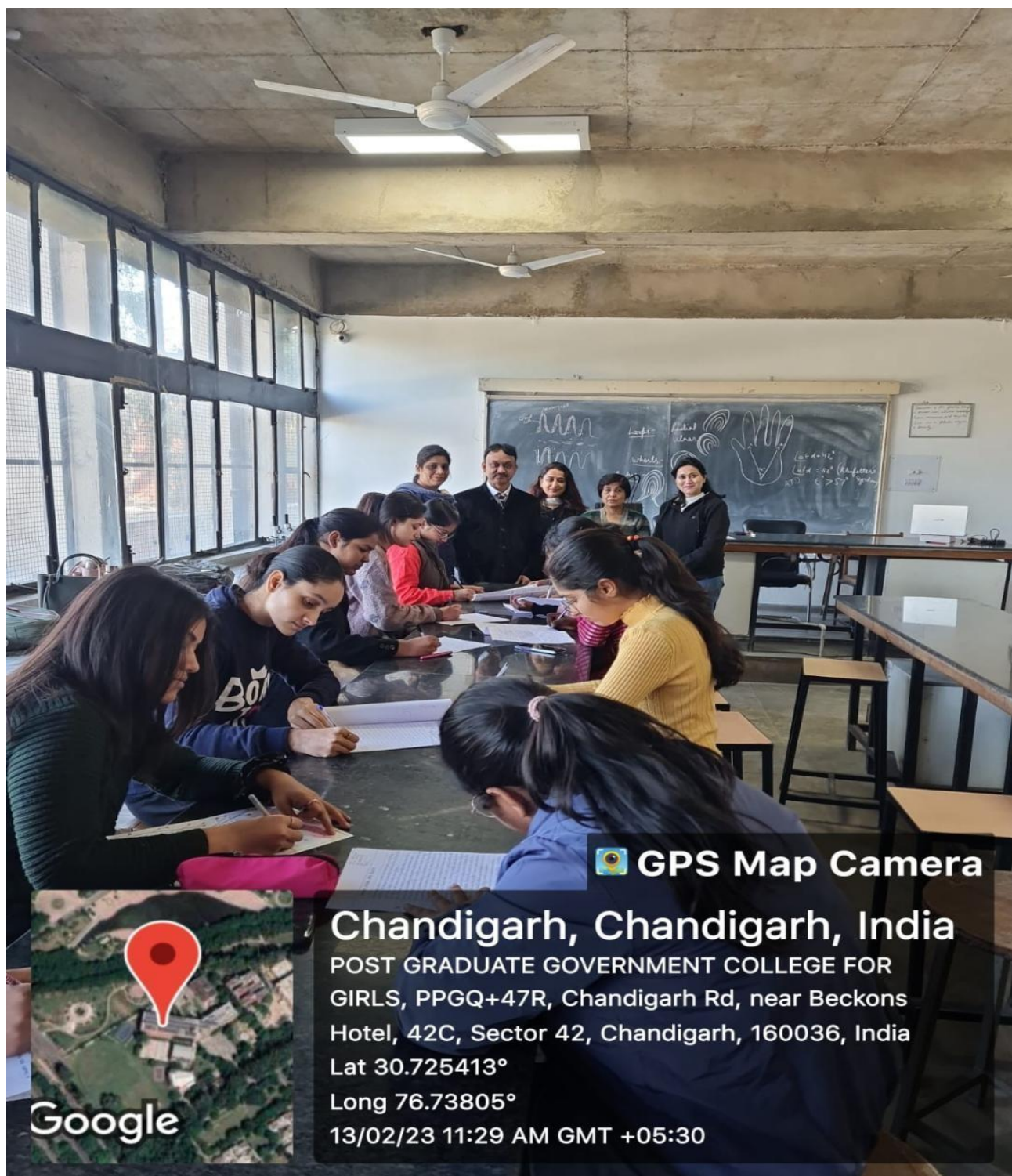

- For India, the G20 Presidency also marks the beginning of "Amrit Kaal", the 25-year period beginning from the 75th anniversary of its Independence on 15 August 2022, leading up to the centenary of its independence, towards a futuristic, prosperous, inclusive and developed society, distinguished by a human-centric approach at its core.

Significance of India's G20 Presidency

- G20 is the premier forum for international economic cooperation representing around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the global trade, and about two-thirds of the world population.
- During the course of its G20 Presidency, India will host about 200 meetings in 32 different sectors in multiple locations across India.

→ The G20 Leaders Summit at the level of Heads of State / Government is scheduled to be held on September 9 and 10, 2023 in New Delhi.

- According to Prime Minister Modi, this term can be an opportunity for India to share its expertise with the world in areas of women empowerment, democracy, and digital technologies.
- As a country with core democratic values, India can show the world that the scope of conflict can come to an end when democracy becomes a culture. This gains significance amidst the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict.
- During India's Presidency, Indonesia and Brazil along with India would form the G20 Trika.
→ It is hoped that as a result there would be a shift in the balance of powers within the G20 favouring emerging economies to have a greater share in decision-making at this grouping.
- The G-20 Presidency presents a great opportunity for India to correct the long-standing anomaly that go against developing countries, especially in the domain of agriculture & food subsidies.

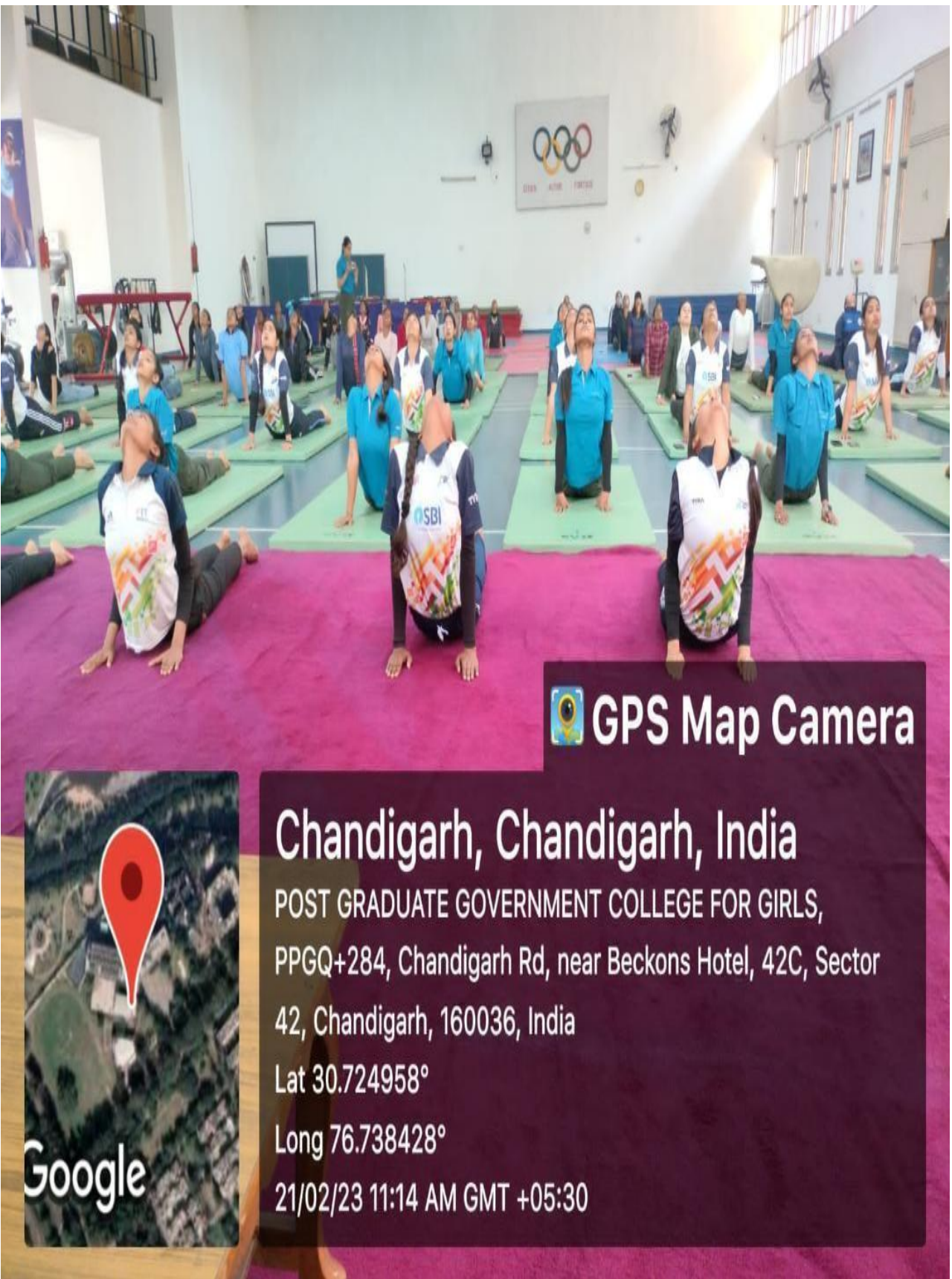
The G20 Summit, the group's first post-pandemic Summit, recently took place in Bali, Indonesia in the backdrop of the Russia-Ukraine crisis.

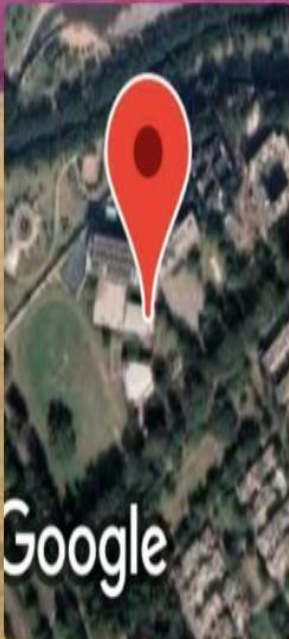

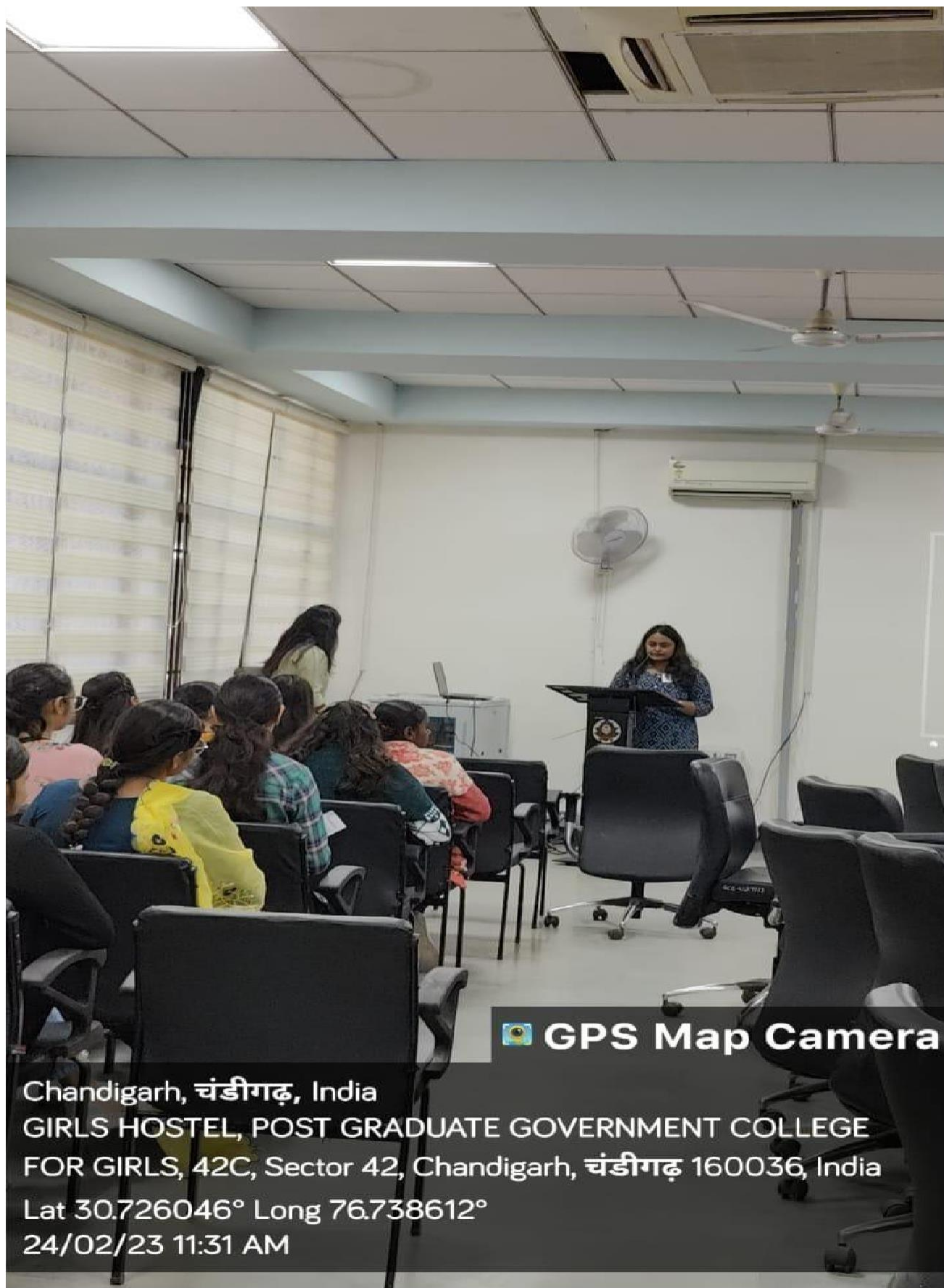

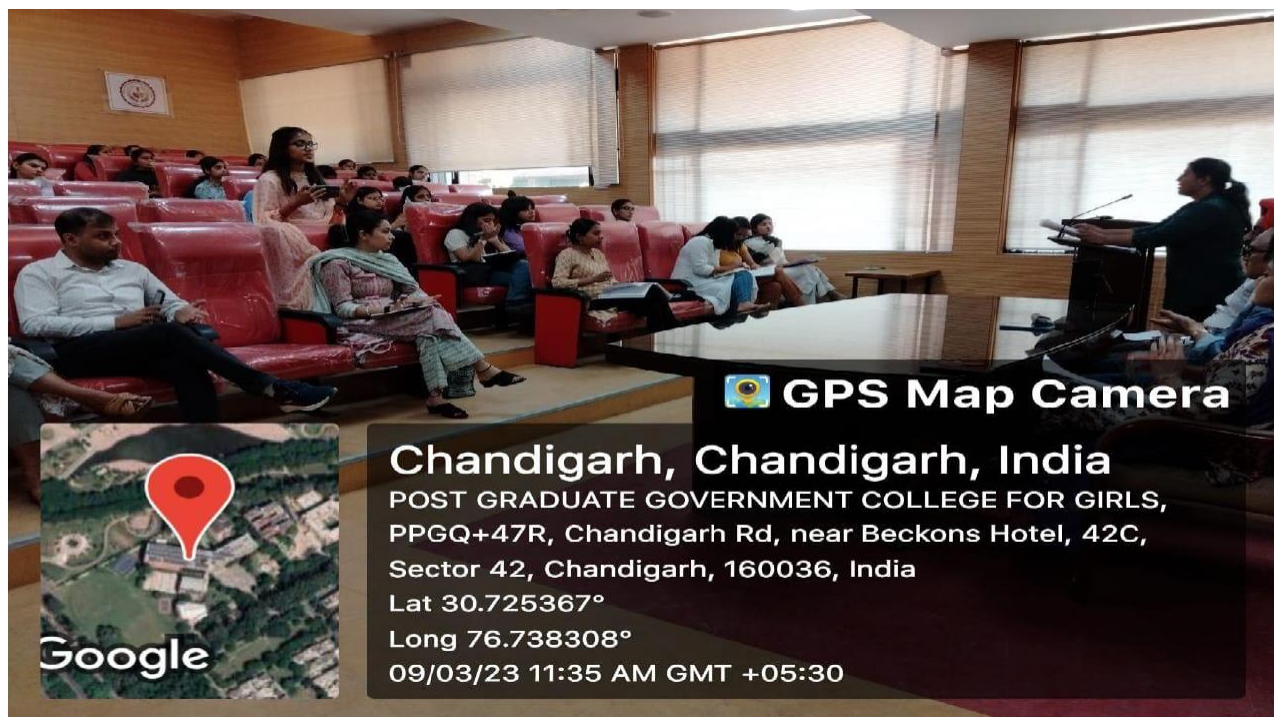
