# Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42, Chandigarh LITERARY SOCIETY Report (2016-2023)

The Literary Society of Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42, Chandigarh functions with the overt aim to develop the imaginative faculties of students by encouraging them to give free expression to their ideas through various literary forms. The activities of this society are planned to augment the output of the students of the college and thereby impart these values to the student community as a whole. The literary capabilities inherent in the students need to be inhabitant brought out to give flair to their creative aptitude. As a preliminary step, Ms. Sonia Sikand Convenor, with the incessant assistance of Dr Kanchan, Dr Pooja Sharma and Dr Sonia co-ordinators of the society for the session 2022-23, enrolled student members from each semester and class who possessed an inherent interest in literary activities in spite of belonging to varied disciplines. All students of elective languages namely English, Hindi, Punjabi and Sanskrit, students studying PG languages and PGDMC students are compulsory members of the society.

The society organises activities on a quarterly basis in order to provide each student a platform to express their literary ideas and their passion for literary activities. Student coordinators are selected for each activity separately in order to give everyone an equal opportunity. The society has been actively engaging in creative writing, elocution, debate, declamation, story writing, poem recitation and essay writing competitions in order to keep the students engaged throughout the year.

This semester began fruitfully as the Literary Society in collaboration with the Students Council of the college organised a G20 Youth Conference on the topic Net Zero Emissions in which more than 30 students participated enthusiastically.
