- 1. All contributors are requested to send the abstract of the research paper / poster as an email attachment in MS word file format (.doc/docx). The Abstract should include brief summary within 250 words on the research topic with details of author's affiliation, correspondence address and contact number on a separate page.
- 2. Full length research paper should be between 3000 5000 words.
- 3. Follow APA guidelines, the text of the paper will be in double space, 12 font, Times New Roman, keeping a margin of one inch on three sides. MS Word 2007 for Windows (.doc format) is required.
- 4. All submissions will be subjected to blind review process after which we will intimate the authors and request for the final presentation pack.
- 5. Contributions should be restricted to one paper per individual as the first author.
- All correspondence along with abstract and research paper submission should be addressed to <u>con2023@gcg42.ac.in</u>.
- 7. Please mention the name of the first author in the subject box in all correspondence.
- 8. The conference organizers will select high-quality papers presented at the conference for publication in an ISBN book. The selected authors will be notified after the conference and will be provided with detailed instructions on how to submit their papers for publication.
- 9. We encourage all participants to submit their best work for presentation at the conference and for possible publication in the book. This will be a great opportunity to showcase your research and contribute to the growing field of sustainable education aligned with the NEP 2020 and the SDGs 2030.
