- E-certificate will be provided to winners and participants.



# 2. Webinar on the theme "G20 Partnership: Economic Implications for India" held on 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2023

Under the auspices of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav, a webinar was held on the theme "G20 Partnership: Economic Implications for India" on the 12th of June, 2023. The purpose of the webinar was to investigate the role that India's relationship with the G20 plays and the advantages that it provides in a variety of areas, including trade and commerce, employment, tourism, and climate change.

The Principal, Prof. Nisha Aggarwal, opened the webinar with a heartfelt welcome, during which she expressed her thanks to both the guest speaker and the attendees.
