On National Constitution Day, Pledge-taking ceremony was held in the PG. Govt. College for Girls, Sector-42, Chandigarh. The 2023 year marks the 132nd birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who was the chairman of the Drafting Committee of the Constituent Assembly and played a vital role in the drafting of the Constitution. Previously this day was celebrated as Law Day. In 2015 the government of India modified Law Day in the gazette notification and it has been called Constitution Day.

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;


EQUALITY of status and of opportunity and to promote among them all;


