RESPONSIBILITIES OF COLLEGE COUNSELLOR

- Identification of students with problems. To be done through:
- 1. Screening of academic performance.
- 2. Reports of teachers, parents and students
- 3. Through use of standardized psychological tests.
- Provision of guidance and counseling related to:
- 1. Personal Problems
- 2. Educational Problems
- 3. Career and Vocational Concerns
- Provision of activity calendar for tutorial groups.
- Conduct of group personality assessment on a specified date and time by displaying it in form of notice on notice board and classroom announcement.
- Talks related to mental health to be delivered to students in Personality Development classes:

Topics to be covered are:

- 1. Parent –adolescent conflicts
- 2. Heterosexual relationships
- 3. Sexual Abuse
- 4. Laws pertaining to rape, molestation, etc.
- 5. Reproductive health
- 6. Stress Management
- 7. Depression

- 10. Nutritive Diet
- 11. Health and Exercise
- 12. Suicide Prevention
- Organizing workshop/seminars in the college along with different faculties related to holistic development of the students.
- Marinating records and follow up of all the counseling cases that come to us and referrals.
- Taking over the charge of helpline along with other faculty members.
- Involvement in purchase of books and psychological tests required for counseling.
- Sending relevant articles and messages through e- mails to the entire college staff.
- Contacting the parents and teachers in need and discuss the problems as well the action to be taken.
- Informing the principal about chronic cases and keeping her informed time to time about the counseling given.
