COLLEGE PROFILE

At the very outset, I would like to share with great pride that our college has been placed amongst the top 10% colleges of the country in the National Institution Ranking framework, MHRD, Government of India.

MHRD has recently selected this college under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan. This is a national programme with the vision to involve higher educational institutions in the development process of gram panchayats to enable village clusters to achieve sustained development and better quality of life.

Nestled in a sprawling campus of approximately 18 acres in the southern part of the 'City Beautiful', the college has, indeed, matured from a modest beginning in 1982 with 300 students and 14 faculty members into an all-encompassing multi-faculty institute with student strength of 4027.

The college offers 51 courses (UG and PG) with 381 subject combinations in Arts, 13 in Science, Honours in 13 Arts/commerce subjects & Post Graduations in 15 subjects. The college also offers dual degree in the form of graduation with an added option of 11 Add-on Courses.

The new courses introduced from this session are: PG Diploma in Chemical Analysis of Food and Diploma course in Web Designing and Multi Media.; Certificate course in Music Vocal and Music Instrumental.

Excellence in terms of academics, sports, extra-curricular and infrastructure has been possible due to the constant endeavour of the Chandigarh Administration, RUSA, MHRD, DST, PU and UGC in providing us with State of the Art infrastructure, funding and other appropriate facilities.

The Project Approval Board (PAB) of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) of MHRD, Govt. of India has approved a grant of Rs. 2 Crore under Infrastructure Head to our college out of which of Rs. 1.50 Crore has been released to set up:

- A dedicated research lab for life sciences which is the first of its kind in any city colleges.
- A day care centre which facilitates and supports students and staff.
- Renovation of additional class rooms
- Upgradation of LIBSYS software.

Chandigarh Administration has generously released a grant of approx. 3.5 crores for upgradation of infrastructure and resources.

(FIST) Fund for Improvement of Science & Technology Scheme of Department of Science and Technology has accorded financial assistance to the tune of seventy Lakhs out of which 39 lakhs has been released to the college for strengthening of infrastructure and pedagogy of science subjects.

Financial assistance from Panjab University was also received for conducting a National Workshop “Kala Sangam” on performing arts.

The credit for the multifaceted development of the students also goes to the dedication of highly qualified 130 faculty members which include 64 Ph.Ds and 26 M.Phils under the able stewardship of Prof Binu Dogra who facilitate effectual teaching and mentorship.

54 scholars are registered for PhD under 12 of our faculty members, which is the highest enrolled number amongst the Govt. Colleges of the city. 2 PhD scholars under the guidance of Prof. Sudhir Hindwan and Prof. Jyoti Seth have been awarded degrees this year.

Four of the members of the college faculty namely Dr. Jyoti Seth, Dr. Neelam Sharma, Dr Indu Jindal and Dr Sudhir Hindwan have been elevated to the post of Professors, taking the number to 12 and 2 of the faculty have been promoted as Associate professors. There are presently 48 Associate Professors, 70 Assistant Professors to guide the students. 44 of the faculty are members of the Board of Studies of Panjab University and are engaged in the academic upgradation of the curriculum of the university. Another 8 are added members of different faculties of PU, Chandigarh.

- One of our faculty members, Dr Dalip Kumar is a Senator and Dean, Faculty of Dairying, Animal Husbandry and Agriculture, P U Chandigarh for the session 2018-19. He has been deputed as ASPD, RUSA.
- It is a matter of pride that Prof. Saubhagya Vardhan, our former colleague has been appointed as Director, North Zone Cultural Centre, Patiala.
- Prof. Jyoti Seth was awarded ‘Vishishth Mahila Samman, by Sanskar Bharti on 8th March, 2018 for her momentous efforts towards Women empowerment.
- Prof Manjit Kaur has been accorded the Literary Excellence award by Pragati Educational Council recently.
- Prof Sudhir Hindwan has been conferred the honour of being the Convener of Peace History Commission of International Peace Research Association, Belgium for its various international conferences.
- Dr Harjeet Kaur, Dept of Physics has been involved in a sterling initiative of care-giving of Children suffering from renal failure and cancer at PGI, Chandigarh

- Dr Neelima Talwar was felicitated by Centre of Social Work, PU, for her contribution in the field of rehabilitation of stray animals.
- Our faculty has been actively engaged in research. They have published 400 papers in international and national journals and 100 book publications to their credit.
- 32 major and minor projects in diverse arenas have been awarded to the faculty which is the highest in any city college.
- Prof. Punam Agarwal along with Mr Sudhir, Ms Nidhi and Ms Anu of BCA Dept. have completed two consultancy projects funded by Punjab Infotech and NIELIT, GOI respectively.
- Mr. Ram Niwas Yadav has clinched the Gold Medal in Athletics and two Bronze medals in Tennis and Basket Ball in 1st National Masters Games held in Chandigarh in April 2018.
- Dr Ranjay Vardhan has the distinction of publishing a Paper “Elder Abuse and Elder Victimization” in International Annals of Criminology, Cambridge University Press, in Feb. 2018
- Dr Nemi Chand presented Research Paper ‘Towards Improved Public Distribution System for Sustainable Livelihood of Poor people in India through Direct Benefit Transfer Scheme: An Empirical study of Chandigarh’ in 3rd International Conference on Public Policy (ICPP3) – Singapore on June 28-30, 2017. So far 11 members of the faculty have made academic presentations overseas.
- Mr T C Garg has initiated an online learning resource via You Tube for Commerce students, which is a step towards fulfilling the e- learning program, MHRD.
- The college has the honour of promoting I T literacy through E- learning in collaboration with IIT Bombay as an initiative of National Mission of Education through ICT, MHRD.

About 120 non-teaching members provide assistance in the smooth functioning of the college.

SUPPORT SYSTEM

RUSA, UGC, New Delhi; Panjab University, Chandigarh and Dept. of Higher Education, Chandigarh Administration are our major support systems.

In addition, our college Administrative Branch, Examination Branch, Hostel and Library work in close confluence and ensure smooth running of the college.

RUSA (MHRD) GRANT

Under the Project Approval Board (PAB) of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) of MHRD, Govt. of India a grant of **Rs. 1.50 Crore** under Infrastructure Head to our college was received for new construction, upgradation and procurement. A dedicated research lab, a day care centre, renovation of two class rooms, library software LIBSYS and washrooms has been undertaken this session.

Financial assistance from Panjab University was received for conducting a National Workshop “Kala Sangam” on performing arts.

ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK

We have a fully automated office which has dedicated and committed administrative staff led by Mrs. Kawaljit Kaur and Ms Madhu Bala. The services of the Administrative staff are an integral and indispensable part of the functioning of the college and a fully computerized office has made the working of the Administrative Branch better organized and more efficient.

EXAMINATION BRANCH

The college examination branch is a confidential section with the responsibility of smooth conduct of Mid-Semester exams, University Examinations and competitive Exams for all the UG & PG courses on the basis of which internal assessment is calculated and Annual Prize Distribution is held. 4 Examination centres are allotted for Semester Exams. Also various competitive examinations of National and State repute are assigned to the college by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time. Some of the important entrance examinations worth mentioning here are Civil Services, NDA, PCS, HCS, CET, BSRB, RRB, IB, SLIET, MES, and UGC etc

Our College is amongst the first few Colleges which has adopted PU Examination Appointment Project Online.

It is pertinent to state that College Examination Branch is equipped with BIZHUB-German make Printing Machine for printing of confidential papers etc. which helps to save Govt. funds to the extent of 40%. Revenue from other sources such as disposal of used answer sheets is generated from time to time for improving exam infrastructure.

HOSTEL

264 students were admitted to the hostel in the session 2016-17. The hostel - ‘a home away from home’ brings together students from different parts of the country bringing about an intermingling of cultures. At present, there are students from 12 states namely J&K, H.P, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Rajasthan, Uttranchal, Leh, Ladakh, UP, Bihar, Kerala, West Bengal

And Tibet in the 16 wings of the college hostel. 33 students are accommodated in the Government Hostel, Sector –24, Chandigarh. 9 students were given accommodation in SCERT institute, sec 32, Chd. The college provides adequate facilities for the recreation of the hostlers -TV room with DVD, a small Library, study room, in-door games, sick- room and a meditation room; computers, internet & non-conventional energy resources like solar geysers and Solar Lights. In this session the hostellers were also provided with wi-fi facility. This year, the college organised Hostel Athletic Meet, the first of its kind in any of the city colleges, wherein the hostlers showed their prowess in sports

LIBRARY

The college library is fully automated and caters to the academic and educational needs of the students and the staff. During the current session more than 1,300 books have been added to the existing stock, taking the number to more than 41000 books. In addition to this the library subscribes to 74 magazines, 14 subject journals (approx.) and 18 newspapers in Hindi, English and Punjabi to keep the students and staff abreast with current affairs in home and abroad. INFLIBNET facility to access E-Books & Journal .Web OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) facility is available in the library using which the staff and students can search the books through various approaches like author, title, accession number, publisher, subject, or a combination of these.

The library has one Digital Corner for Rare Books (50 Books) and a Braille Corner for visually challenged students and has procured JAWS and LIBSYS Software. Reference Books are also issued to students for 2 days. Internet facility and Photostat Facility is available in the Library for students. Presently the Greenstone library software to facilitate the Staff and Students is under process for accessing Syllabus and question papers from the year 2017-18.

PLACEMENT CELL

Placement Cell caters to campus placements & prepares the students to be financially independent and self-sufficient after completing their course/degree in the college. Our aim is to reach out to the maximum number of students and ensure their participation in motivational talks & interactive sessions on Career Guidance and employability skills. Placement Cell provides information to the students on regular basis about vacancies in private & public sectors advertised online and offline and facilitates them in job applications. Multinational & national companies such as IBM, Concentrix, WIPRO, HDFC Standard Life Insurance, DLF Pramerica, Aircel, Genpact, Aviva Insurance, WNS Global Services have been visiting our college and conducting placement drives. During this session 46 students have been given offer letters by Concentrix Corporation Pvt Ltd & Tech

Mahindra Limited with the average pay package of upto 2.76 & 1.56 lacs per annum. This year, 46 students have been given placement offers by different companies.

Keeping with the need to fill the gap between the current educational potential of graduates & post graduates and the growing market demands, our focus is to equip our students with the employability skills so as to facilitate them in finding jobs as they leave the institute. In this regard, as many as 19 training sessions and 5 workshops were organised on CV writing, Interview Skills, Group Discussion, Reasoning, General Awareness, Communication Skills in which 300 students participated. 3 aptitude/ scholarship test were also conducted under the sponsorship of Bulls Eye, IBS & Chankya IAS Academy during this session in which 218 students participated. 45 hours Course (free of cost) sponsored by SKD Learning for Hostel students on CV Writing, Personality Development & Interview Preparation has been initiated w.e.f Feb,2018 where about 60 students are participating. Computers with internet facility are already installed in the placement cell for the use of students. Students visit the department in their free period and make use of this facility in the room. 2 deserving students of B.Com III, Arshdeep & Sonia Goyal have been recommended for free coaching classes in Bulls eye Institute, Chandigarh.

LABORATORIES

The college has thirty nine laboratories in the subjects of Botany, Chemistry, Physics, Zoology, Bio-Technology, Microbiology, Bio-informatics, Computer Science, BCA, Functional English, Functional Hindi, Geography, Psychology, Fine Arts, Dance, Music Vocal and Instrumental, cosmetology and Home Science. These labs are equipped with all relevant items as per University norms. This year the college has added a dedicated research lab for life sciences.

FEE CONCESSIONS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

As far as Scholarships and Fee Concessions are concerned, 132 students have been given Student Aid Fund of Rupees 3,000 each amounting to Rupees 3 lakhs 96 thousand, while Fee Concession has been given to 398 students in 2017-18. 224 Arts and 40 students from Science stream of SC/ST category have been provided with books and stationery worth RS 70,000/- by U T administration.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Extracurricular activities are integral to holistic education. Indubitably, such activities also hone “Soft Skills” of the students enabling them to chisel and promote social interaction, time management, public relations, community service along with skills specific to their career path and future job success. Realizing that in today’s competitive globalised world, future employers seek individuals with these increased skill levels, making these

talented students more sought-after in the job market; we encourage students to marshal their skills by allowing them to participate in the extra-curricular activities.

Our college students bagged 38 prizes including 10 first prizes, 09 second prizes, 19 third prizes. We also won 6 individual prizes in the Zonal Youth Festival and 2 individual prizes in the Inter-Zonal festival.

Our student, Saumya brought home the 2nd prize in Indian Classical Dance (Solo) in the PU Inter Zonal Youth Festival held in this session. She has also received the “Young Women Achievers Award” from Governor, Haryana on Women’s Day this year.

The session has been abuzz with activity. A number of activities viz., Talent Hunt Competitions, Inter College and Intra College Quiz, Debates, Declamations, Folk Song and Poetry Recitation Competitions were organized during the session. Many lectures, seminars, symposia and workshops were also held for the awareness of the students.
